Statistics

- **Worldwide** confirmed cases surpassed 69 million yesterday, after nearly 698,000 new infections were reported globally. Total deaths stood at 1.58 million.
- The **ASEAN+3 region** saw around 14,700 new cases yesterday, its second highest daily increase so far.
- **China** reported 15 new infections yesterday, slightly higher than the previous day's figure. Of the new cases, six were classified as local transmission.
- **Hong Kong** reported 112 new infections yesterday, marking its third consecutive day of at least 100 new cases daily. Of the total, 102 were local transmission cases, 34 of which remain unlinked to known cases. Total confirmed infections stood near 7,300.
- Daily new cases in Japan reached a new record for the second day yesterday, after around 2,980 new infections were reported. 602 of the new cases were confirmed in Tokyo, its highest daily figure yet. Total confirmed cases surpassed 172,000.
- **Korea** reported around 690 new infections yesterday, up from the previous day, and the highest since late February. Of the new cases, 250 were Seoul residents, while 16 were imported. Total confirmed infections rose above 40,700 with 572 deaths.
- Daily new cases in Indonesia remained above 6,000 for the second day yesterday, pushing its total infections near 599,000. It also recorded 165 new deaths, easing from the previous day's figure.
- **Cambodia** yesterday confirmed 1 more local transmission case that is linked to the community event last November 28, bringing the total number of positive cases traced back to the incident to 39.
- Total confirmed cases in Myanmar surpassed 104,000 yesterday, after it reported around 1,320 new infections. Total deaths rose above 2,200.

News

- The **World Trade Organization** yesterday delayed its decision on a proposed waiver of intellectual property rules for COVID-19 drugs and vaccines. The proposal by **India** and **South Africa**, which aims to grant compulsory licensing of the vaccines, will thus allow generic manufacturers to produce the drugs. Some economies have opposed the proposal, including the **United Kingdom**, **Switzerland** and the **United States**. Talks are expected to continue until 2021, beyond this year's deadline.
- **Korea** will mobilise its military personnel, along with the police and government workers, in every district of the greater Seoul area to track all potential infections. Temporary testing sites across 150 locations will be launched on Monday (December 14). Shipping containers are being converted into temporary wards to help ease the strain on the medical system.
- A **United States** government advisory panel yesterday endorsed the widespread use of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine. Vaccination could begin within days, depending on how soon the Food and Drug Administration's signs off the panel's recommendation.
- The passenger who previously tested positive on board Royal Caribbean's cruise ship last Wednesday is now confirmed as negative by **Singapore's** Ministry of Health. The individual was tested three more times since Wednesday, December 9, and all yielded negative results.
