Statistics

- Worldwide **confirmed cases** stood at 99.7 million yesterday, with more than 520,000 new infections globally. At least 10,500 new deaths were also recorded.
- The **ASEAN+3** region saw <u>more than 19,200 new cases yesterday,</u> pushing total confirmed cases near 2.5 million.
- **China** recorded <u>82 new infections yesterday, easing from the previous day's figure of 124</u>. Of the new cases, 69 were local infections. Total confirmed cases stood near 89,200.
- <u>Daily new cases</u> in <u>Japan reached around 2,800 yesterday</u>, falling below the 3,000-mark for the first time since end-December 2020. Tokyo's daily infections also fell to 618 yesterday, marking its fourth-straight day of decline.
- **Korea** saw its <u>daily new infections ease to 354 yesterday, from more than 400 the previous</u> day. Of the new cases, 16 were imported. Total confirmed cases stood above 75,800.
- Malaysia recorded <u>around 3,050 new cases yesterday</u>, the <u>second-straight day of decline</u>. Total confirmed infections surpassed 186,000, with total deaths near 690.
- Thailand confirmed <u>at least 900 new infections yesterday</u>, all linked to the Samut Sakhon province near Bangkok, pushing its total confirmed tally past 14,000. Most of the new cases were migrant workers.

News

- Lab studies showed that US drug maker Moderna's vaccine is still protective against the new variants of the COVID-19 virus from the United Kingdom and South Africa. The company will test adding a new booster to its vaccine to increase its efficacy against the South African strain, after tests showed that the current two-dose vaccine resulted in a diminished antibody response to this variant.
- Thailand will begin its vaccination program next month from February 14, using 50,000 doses of the vaccine from AstraZeneca. Those in high-risk groups will be prioritized, including medical personnel, frontline workers, and those with higher infection risks. This will be the first of a three-phase vaccination roll-out plan.
- The European Union will soon require pharmaceutical companies producing COVID-19
 vaccines within EU to register in advance any exports of doses to third economies. To
 support this, the European Commission will be creating a transparency register for vaccine
 exports outside of the bloc.
- **Pfizer** has <u>filed an application seeking approval of its COVID-19 vaccine for use</u> in **Korea**. The decision on this application is expected within 40 days. Authorities are planning to begin inoculations next month.
